DECEMBER 2009 EXAMINATIONS

If you have registered to sit an exam in December you can check if your exam request has been processed in the Exam Service section of the Student Services website:

<https://cws.ebsmba.com/student-service/>.

Check that the "Diet" column has "D09" which stands for December 2009.

The "**d**" in the left margin is the next action you can perform, which in this case is deferring your exam should you wish to. Alternatively you can click on the word "defer" in the "Actions".

If you do not plan to defer your exam, no further action is required apart from showing up on time at the exam centre to write your exam!

DEFERRALS - DECEMBER 2009 EXAMINATIONS

If you feel unprepared or if your circumstances change in the run up to the examinations, you can defer your examination (described above) without financial penalty before the deadline date of **November 1st, 2009** for the December examination diet. After this date, you can defer up to the day of the examination, but this will be considered a late deferral and you would therefore forfeit the examination fee.

Your examination date will be transferred automatically to the next major diet, unless you specify an alternative diet.

GRADUATION

The November graduation will be held at Heriot-Watt University on 19th November 2009. Graduation packs have been sent out to all successful graduands and packs will be sent to those students who have met the requirements. Students are not considered to be graduates until the degree is conferred at this ceremony and therefore cannot use the relevant initials until that time.
