PROFESSOR LUMSDEN'S VISIT

On a recent trip to North America, Prof Keith Lumsden and his wife Ruth were the guests of honour at functions held in Toronto and New York for graduates and students.



Prof. Lumsden outlined the development of the EBS MBA and the additional programmes now offered by EBS. He spoke of how the EBS courses were centered

on the philosophy that students learn not by hearing or seeing, but by doing. He also spoke of his empirical research that demonstrated how, regardless of resources available to students, ability was the main determinant of success. These two elements led to the launch of the EBS distance learning MBA in 1989/90. By 1994 EBS was the biggest business school in Europe and by 1996 the biggest business school in the United States of America.

Prof Lumsden also stressed the value of our student and graduate bodies, emphasizing the fact that these groups were both avid supporters of EBS and its strongest ambassadors. EBS relies on its ambassadors for the word of mouth recommendations that our students and alumni make to their friends and colleagues.



The reception events also allowed everyone in attendance to mingle and network over drinks and canapés and we look forward to the next time everyone is able to meet and network in this fashion.

JUNE 2010 EXAMINATION RESULTS

Examination results will be posted on the Student Services website approximately six weeks after the date of examination. Your official June examination results will be dispatched directly to you by the end of July to the last mailing address notified.

EBS will not advise examination results over the phone under any circumstances.

If you marginally fail a course (i.e. attain a mark of between 45% and 49%) you may be eligible for the award of compensatory pass, subject to the successful

completion of all remaining courses. In such cases, a maximum of two compensatory passes will be awarded, provided that the total shortfall is 5% or less.

AUGUST EXAMINATIONS

A minor examination diet will be held in August in Toronto and Calgary. Finance is scheduled for the morning of Wednesday, August 18, 2010 and Strategic Planning on Thursday, August 19, 2010.

The deadline date for examination application AND deferral is July 24. It is not possible to request an extension to this deadline date. Please therefore complete the registration process in good time bearing in mind the time difference between Canada and Scotland.

DECEMBER EXAMINATIONS

The next major examination diet for all courses will be held in December 2010. The deadline date for examination applications is September 1st.
